

ORDINANCE NO. 360


AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHVILLE, COUNTY OF DAUPHIN, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 332 OF THE BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHVILLE, WHICH ORDINANCE REQUIRES CURBS, SIDEWALKS, AND GUTTERS TO BE MAINTAINED BY THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS, PROVIDING THE CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CURBS, SIDEWALKS, GUTTERS AND THE RIGHT OF WAY STANDARDS.

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 332 is amended to add paragraph 15 which shall read as follows:

- A. When repairing a sidewalk in accordance with the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Elizabethville, Chapter 21, Part 3, the material to be used for said repair can only be used if the material is currently in place. That material includes brick, slate, or concrete with no more than $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch between material joints.
- B. When a full replacement of curbing and or sidewalk is made, concrete must be used per ordinance specifications.
- C. When repairing or replacing curbing and or sidewalk, asphalt may not be used.
- D. When designated by the Borough engineer, a roll curb may be used in limited circumstances and at the discretion of the Borough.

All other provisions of Ordinance 332 remain in effect as stated. Adopted as an Ordinance of the Borough of Elizabethville on the 12th day of March, 2018 and effective immediately.
