The Borough of Elizabethville will be hosting their Bicentennial Grand Parade on **Saturday, August 19, 2017.**

The Parade will begin at the intersection of Market and Clearfield Streets (12:00 noon) and will travel South on Market Street, East on Broad Street, South on Moore Street, West on Main Street, North on Bender Street, East on Broad Street, North on Church Street to the UDA High School. **NO PARKING – Vehicles on the parade route or the following streets during the times specified will be towed at the owner’s expense.**

Residents, business owners & employers located inside the parade route are advised that vehicles will not be permitted to cross the parade route except in an emergency. Local deliveries and residents affected by the road closures on these routes may be delayed or rerouted until the route is reopened to vehicles.

Traffic control and detours will be in place but motorists should be aware that normal routes will be affected by the parade. A total by-pass of Elizabethville Borough will begin at **11:00 am** and continue for approximately 3 hours.

If you are attending the parade, we suggest you arrive prior to the **11:00 am Street Closure** time. Parking is available at RiteScreen on the east end of town and at Alvord Polk on the west end of town. Shuttle service will be provided. Reserved parking for handicap vehicles is available at The Special Place, Hoover-Boyer Funeral Home, Fisher Auto Parts and Upper Dauphin Storage. If you are not attending the parade, you may want to avoid Elizabethville to minimize your frustration with the street closures and heavy volume of traffic.

The parade will also close several streets and restrict parking on many Borough Streets.

### **Detours**

- Traffic entering from the North will be detoured onto Rakers Mills Road.
- Traffic coming from the South will be diverted to Route 147 in Halifax.
- Traffic entering Elizabethville from the West will be detoured onto Wilhour Road.
- Traffic entering town from the East will be detoured onto Rakers Mill Road.
