Elizabethville Borough Permit Requirements:

- 1. The permit issued by the Borough shall be visible on the property.
- 2. Any temporary container, such as a dumpster of bagster, placed on any street in the Borough shall have lights, cones or some type of visibility/reflective marker located on and around the dumpster.
- 3. Any temporary container, dumpster or bagster that is situated on grass, topsoil or on a street in the Borough, shall be placed on wooden pallets.
- 4. The person securing the permit shall keep the area around the dumpster free of refuse, debris, nails or screws and any other type of material.
- 5. When Containers, dumpsters and bagsters are not in use, they must be covered and secure to prevent debris from being blown or washed out of the container.
- 6. The permit is only valid for up to 4 weeks from the date issued for dumpsters placed on any Borough street. Permit may be renewed by application prior to the expiration date.
- 7. There shall be a fee for the permit, said fee set by resolution of the Borough Council.
- 8. A temporary container, such as dumpster or bagster, in one that is on the property specific one-time purpose, such as construction debris from contracting work or clean-out of a property, and the dumpster is not there for the day to day disposal of municipal waste on a permanent basis.
 - a. CONSTRUCTION/DEMOLITION WASTE solid waste resulting from the construction or demolition of buildings and other structures, including, but not limited to wood, plaster, metals, asphaltic substances, bricks, block and un-segregated concrete. The term does not include the following if they are separate from other waste and are used as clean fill.
 - 1 Uncontaminated soil, rock, stone, gravel, brick and block, concrete and used asphalt.
 - 2 Waste from land clearing, grubbing and excavation, including trees, brush, stumps and vegetative material.
 - b. RUBBISH all solid household wastes, except body wastes, other than garbage and ashes, such as magazines, glass other than containers, ceramics, plastics other than beverage-containers and laundry detergent containers, small scraps of wood, etc.

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Unacceptable items for dumpsters:

- a. HAZARDOUS WASTE- any waste which is virtue of its quantity or content presents a hazard to the individuals handling it, a hazard to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or which makes land unfit or undesirable for normal use; including, but not limited to, herbicides, explosives, pathological wastes, radioactive materials and any materials defined as hazardous wastes by Federal or State law or regulations. Oil drum tanks, liquids paints varnish, lead paint, thinners, antifreeze, motor oil, used oil filters or absorbents.
- b. Gas Propane tanks
- c. Tires, car batteries, rechargeable batteries
- d. Explosives or fireworks
- e. Appliances
- f. Florescent lights/ballast
- g. Electronics computers, printers, monitors, keyboards, mice, televisions, DVD players, VCR and other video players, fax machine, cell phones and cameras.
