Snow Removal

Residents are reminded that sidewalks must be cleared of snow and/or ice to a width of 30” no later than 12 hours after it stops snowing. We also ask our residents to please keep fire hydrants clear of snow.

In the event of a severe winter storm, the Mayor may declare a snow emergency; The Snow Emergency Declaration will be announced on WQLV FM 98.9 (www.wqlvfm.com) /and CBS 21 WHP (www.local21news.com) and on the Borough website, *www.elizabethville.org*. All snow emergency routes in the Borough have been identified with proper signage. Please visit our Snow Emergency page for more information.

Just a friendly reminder to property owners in the Elizabethville Borough: It is your responsibility to keep your mailboxes, shrubbery basketball hoops, etc from overhanging the edge of the street. This also includes trees that are restricting any signs. Signs need to be visible at all times. Trees are to be trimmed to provide a minimum clearance of 9’ over sidewalks and 16’ over streets and alleys. This is necessary to ensure safety of those activities that must occur close to the curb (snow plowing, street sweeping, trash removal). This is also for the safety of Emergency equipment.
